- All entries and draws will be done through SaddleBook. No entry cut-off
- NO DOGS allowed in the indoor arena. \$100 fine will be issued for dogs found in the indoor arena.
- Horse must be named on entry form. Please enter with horse's registered name. If not registered, enter barn name.
- Horse and rider must run in order drawn or be disqualified. There is no charge for a horse change in the Youth and/or 5D for horses that are not already included in the draw. Please see the office before the race starts on the day of change.

## Friday night 5:00 pm, no dress code

- Men's 4D (1/2 Sec Split)
- Open 5D ½ Sec. Side-pots:
- Member Incentive 4D (1/2 Sec Split) for current 2019 UBRA & Barrel Buddies Members.
- Youth 3D full sec (15 & Under day of race)
- Stuck in the middle 4D ½ sec (16-49 day of race)
- 50+ 4D ½ sec (50 & older day of race)

### • Sat & Sunday 9:00 am, No Dress Code

- Sat only High Stakes 4D 100% payout (1/2 sec) Can c/o to youth, open and side pots.
- Youth 3D Sat & Sun 9:00 am full second split for any rider 15 years and younger day of the race. Youth
  can carry over to Open 5D, Xtreme Million & Target Race.

Youth 3D Average awards will be based on the fastest time from each day.

- Open 5D Sat & Sun will run after Youth and will be ½ second split. 70% of entry fee & 100% of added money will be jackpotted. 5D Average awards will be based on the fastest time from each day. Side-pots:
  - 50+ 4D ½ sec (50 yrs old or older day of race)
  - Stuck in the Middle 4D ½ sec (16-49 yrs old day of race)
  - Xtreme Million Qualifier Side-pot Enter separately on SaddleBook
  - WPRA: Rider must be WPRA member to enter WPRA Permit Side-pot and can enter one time/one horse.
  - 2D Futurity side-pot is full second split for current year futurity eligible horses 4 & 5 years old.
  - 2D Derby is ½ sec. split, open to all 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year horses 5, 6 & 7 years old. WPRA co sanctioned.
  - \$1000 Cash Target Race side-pot, horse and rider with the two closest times Sat & Sun will win \$1000 cash! Target prizes will also be awarded.
- Dress code No Dress Code.
- **Themes** are (encouraged, but not required): Friday Patriotic! Saturday Glitter Like Gold, Sunday Colors for Cancer Awareness.
- Late entries will be taken through SaddleBook unil the last runner and will be charged a \$10 late fee. Late entries will run at the end on Saturday and Sunday.
- **Pre-entered day runners** will be included in the draw. There will be separate draws done for the Youth and Open 5D Saturday and Sunday. Late entries will run at the end both Saturday and Sunday.
- Running Order:

Friday: 5pm, Men's 4D, Open 5D

Saturday: 9am High Stakes, Youth 3D, Open 5D.

Sunday: 9am Youth 3D, Open. New draw each day.

Drag every 5, big drag before Open and every 50 runners. Youth and 5D Average Awards Presentation Sunday after race. Must be present or have a designated person pick up your award at the race.

- All runners will enter the arena thru the alley way and exit out the alley way. No exceptions. One circle is allowed. If you are in the warm-up arena, please be cautious and courteous of horses running in and out of the alley way. The next 15 runners will be the only horses allowed in the warm-up arena.
- Horses will not be worked on markers and barrels are not allowed in the arena during open ride or any other time except during UBRA time only.
- Stall and RV Reservations are handled by Wasatch County: visit <a href="www.utbra.com">www.utbra.com</a> September page, follow the link to Wasatch County's stall reservation system. Stall will be open Thursday. Cleaning fees will be refunded electronically by Wasatch County after the event. No outside shavings allowed and please do not tie horses to trailers overnight.
- **Dr/Vet Outs** 70% of entry fees will be refunded with Dr/Vet release. Must notify office before race starts. Refunds will be mailed 3 weeks after the race ends. **Email releases to ubra.ut@gmail.com**
